

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

The Diphu Government College, Diphu has been recognized as the premiere educational institution of this hill district of Karbi Anglong of Assam under Sixth Schedule area. With an average number of students around 4,500 and teaching and non-teaching staff members of more than 200, having been accommodated with 15 departments under three streams – Science, Arts and Commerce; three hostels; 36 residential quarters, the college produces a considerable quantity of biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste materials. Since, there are no proper disposal facilities of wastes in the college premises, the college decided to take the help of third party for managing the waste of all kinds by making a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Diphu Municipal Board as a process of waste management.


